

In March the Ecole Connaught Community School Council made a presentation to the Regina Public School Board that outlined problems we and parents at other schools encounter as a result of the lack of consistent, quality, free lunchtime supervision for all students. We asked the School Board to fund and administer lunchtime supervision, rather than relying on volunteer-run fee-for-service programs. To ensure the school board members don't forget how important this issue is, we now need to follow up that presentation with letters from parents. Letters work!
